Ref: Information on FBI Special Agent Lindley DeVecchio and Gregory Scarpa, Jr.

To Mr. Hynes:

The following is provided for your information as it relates to the actions of FBI Supervising Special Agent DeVecchio and Mafia capo Scarpa, and the present indictment your office obtained against DeVecchio:

- Starting four years ago, I started receiving several letters from Gregory Scarpa, Jr, in which he described to me the criminal relationship that FBI Supervisory Special Agent DeVecchio had with his father, including divulging the names of government informants; the murder of such informants by his father after receiving this information; and other criminal activities.
- The information had been provided to me as Gregory Scarpa, Jr. sought to have me write a book about him and the Mafia segment that he and his father were involved. I obtained a signed agreement to write the book, but his daughter later requested that I rescind the agreement, which I did.
- About three years ago, I had contacted members of Congress offering them the information and letters that I received, with the intention to provide information to bring about an indictment of FBI Supervisory Special Agent DeVecchio.
- Because of the FBI culture in the Boston office that was associated with several decades of similar criminal conduct by FBI agents involved with the Bulger crime group, and what I had learned over the years from various CIA, FBI, and other sources, I felt that the culture in the FBI's Boston and New York offices was reflective of a culture nationwide. It could be expected to have played a role in the FBI's performance prior to 9/11 relating to terrorism.
- Despite the gravity of the criminal matters and their effect upon FBI responsibilities—and upon national security, not a single response was received from the members of Congress that I contacted. (This has been a standard reaction for many years, commencing first when I was a federal aviation safety agent seeking to report deep-seated misconduct within the government aviation safety offices and the relationship to a series of fatal airline crashes; information on drug smuggling, secret funding and arming of Iran and Iraq, and other crimes against the United States. It is virtually impossible to get members of Congress to respond to insiders seeking to provide information of crimes against the United States that involve people in government positions!)
- I am a former federal agent who, out of concern about corruption in government offices, sought to make this information known to the public through not-for-profit books. The books are based upon facts and documentation that I have received over several decades, including that which I personally discovered while holding a key position in the government's aviation safety offices (where much of the blame lies for the conditions that enabled four groups of hijackers to seize four airliners on 9/11); and information received from former CIA, some of whom were the heads of major secret CIA companies conducting unlawful activities; from FBI agents, including one who worked under DeVecchio and whose

investigative activities were blocked by DeVecchio; and from other insiders. I would be more than willing to provide the information and writings that I have which would provide additional perspective into what I believe is a culture within the FBI that is widespread. This would include letters I received from Gregory Scarpa, Jr. and people who were close to him in prison.
