Ref: Request to know the basis for rejecting filing.

Mr. Whittington:

This is a request for details as to the basis for rejecting the filing of the complaint for which the first page is attached. There are several reasons for this request:

- The right to file is by law, and if I'm denied this right, I have a right to know the reason.
- What is the status of the multiple copies of the complaint and applications that I submitted to the court?
- The Complaint that has been rejected filing is on a heavily trafficked Internet site, and it had been noted on that site that the filing has been rejected, based upon the order of former Justice Department prosecutor and Judge Colleen Kollar-Kotelly.
- Among the issues raised in that complaint is a demand to report and present evidence to the court under the federal crime reporting statute, Title 18 U.S.C. § 4. These federal crimes involved personnel in the FAA and the Department of Justice which I discovered and documented as a federal agent and based upon information provided to me over the years by several dozen present and former government agents. The rejection of that filing thereby blocks the reporting of the criminal activities that I, a former federal air safety agent, and my group of several dozen other government agents, had discovered. Prior judicial blocks have played key roles in the continuation of the conditions arising from this corruption that insured the success of the 9-11 terrorists.
- To be sure no one can claim ignorance of the consequences of this obstruction of justice, I make brief comments. As a former federal air safety agent assigned to the most crash-plagued program in the nation's history, I discovered during my official duties deep-seated culture of corruption and other problems that caused or allowed to occur a long series of air disasters. Among the problems that I discovered were the type of problems that created the conditions that insured the success of the four groups of terrorist hijackers on September 11, 2001.
- A combination of this corruption, and the documented pattern of criminal obstruction of justice were the primary cause for the success of the September 11 terrorist attacks and the deaths of 3,000 people. The continuation of the cover-ups and obstruction of justice will continue the déjà vu tragedies in which September 11 were only the latest blip in a long line of consequences. Further, I and my group of other government agents have discovered numerous other areas of corruption that continues to inflict great harm upon national interests, including national security. Anyone associated with preventing the exposure of these matters becomes criminally implicated, and play a key role in the related tragedies.
- The history of corruption and its felony cover-ups is well documented in letters and
- Since the District of Columbia area felt part of the brunt of September 11, you and every member of

this court recognizes the consequences that follow any actions whatsoever that blocks or hinders the exposure of these matters.
