

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the district court's order filed June 30, 2002, be affirmed. The court properly dismissed appellant's complaint in light of his failure to comply with the standing pre-filing injunction. See Stich v. United States, 773 F. Supp. 469 (D.D.C. 1991), aff'd, 976 F.2d 1445 (D.C. Cir. 1992) (table case).
