Ref: Cover-up by Christian Science Monitor and its deadly consequences

To Mr. Slambrouck:

For years I have made your publication and church aware of documented corruption undermining the security of the United States that continued to inflict grave harm upon many people and upon numerous national interests, including national security. My background provided the credibility and documented evidence showing the tragic consequences of the misconduct and the cover-ups that protects the guilty. Thinking that your newspaper and church had both a moral and legal responsibility to report what I and other government insiders have sought to expose, I had provided to the Monitor and the church information and offered supporting evidence.

Common to many newspapers and most religious groups, you elected to continue the cover-ups, while simultaneously seeking donations that funded the people covering up. The latest consequence of your lack of moral and legal responsibilities occurred on September 11, 2001. In my next book printings I intend to make reference to your cowardly acts. The enclosed draft shows what I intend to include.
