Ref: Your April 27, 1999 letter relating to letter sent to President Ernesto Zedillo

To Mr. Balderas,

In your April 27th letter to me you wanted more information about the matters raised in an earlier letter to President Zedillo. The enclosed book, *Drugging America, A Trojan Horse*, provides the information. The most direct information relating to the information that we provided to President Zedillo can be found on pages 166 to 178 and 360.

A suggestion. These matters are very serious and can reflect very poorly upon President Zedillo for covering up, or doing nothing, about the report by a U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service. That report described a drug operation conducted on Mexican soil by an agent of the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) and the reported murder of a Mexican national in Mexico when that Mexican learned the DEA identity of the DEA agent.

For the president of Mexico to cover up for crimes against the Mexican people is of course very serious and can be used to discredit the president. The book's formal release date is November 1, 1999. It is now being advertised in large half-page and full-page newspaper advertisements. The damage to President Zedillo would be greatly lessened if he promptly came forward and voiced outrage at the matter and demanded an investigation (in the United States, that means a cover-up).

In other parts of the book I describe drug trafficking activities by people in the Mexican government and its military that is not complimentary to Mexico. However, the entire book contains various forms of evidence showing similar political and military involvement in drug trafficking within the United States. In some ways, the U.S. government personnel are committing worse crimes than Mexican government personnel. In the United States, the same government personnel who are legislating draconian prison sentences and imposing sham charges against often times innocent people, or outrageously long charges for non-violent prison offenses, are directly or through cover-ups involved in drug trafficking. Their crimes are far worse in my opinion than those of Mexican government personnel involved in drugs.

Therefore, do not think that I am anti-Mexican by my writings.
