1 MOTION FOR ORDER DIRECTING APPELLEE TO FILE REQUIRED BRIEF, AND
2 FOR SANCTIONS ARISING FROM FAILURE TO FILE

3 Appellant files this motion seeking a court order directing Appellee to file the brief that
4 was required to be filed by February 12, 2004, in accordance with the briefing order filed
5 December 11, 2003.

6 This motion also requests, as provided by that briefing order, that sanctions be ordered
7 against Appellee for refusal to file the Appellee brief.

8 Understandably, Appellee and the U.S. attorney filing the Appellee brief, face a serious
9 problem, which is probably the reason for failing to file that brief. Appellant has sought to
10 report criminal activities that he and a group of other former government agents had
11 discovered as part of their official government duties, some of which created the conditions
12 that encouraged and enabled terrorists to seize four airliners on September 11, 2001.
13 Appellant's Complaint also addressed the violations of federal rights, protections, and
14 defenses that were an integral part of the various attempts to block the reports.

15 These additional violations to block the reporting of criminal activities violated rights
16 under the Civil Rights Act, *Bivens*, Federal Tort Claims Act, RICO, void judgment doctrine,
17 Declaratory Judgment Act, Supreme Court decisions related to these rights, and the due
18 process and equal protection clauses in the U.S. Constitution.

19 Further delay in addressing these matters will continue the great harm arising from the
20 federal offenses, including the obstruction of justice and conspiracy to obstruct, that is
21 obvious from the history of documented judicial events.

22 This motion Appellant Declaration of Filing Irregularities dated February 23, 2004,
23 which was denied filing when earlier submitted.
