14 Plaintiff seeks a court order directing the National  
15 Traffic Safety Board to reopen its investigation of the Pacific  
16 Southwest Airlines air crash in San Diego on September 25, 1978.  
17 Defendant moves to dismiss the action for lack of jurisdiction.

18 Plaintiff alleges two bases for this court's jurisdiction  
19 of the matter: 28 U.S.C. §1361, and section 1007 of the Federal  
20 Aviation Act, codified as 49 U.S.C. §1487. Neither of these  
21 code provisions affords this court jurisdiction. Exclusive  
22 jurisdiction for review of National Traffic Safety Board orders  
23 rests in the U.S. Courts of Appeals. See 49 U.S.C. §1903(d).  
24 Accordingly,

25 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this matter is dismissed.
