Ref: Irrefutable evidence of CIA drug trafficking

Dear Representative Burton:

It was suggested that I send to you information, including the enclosed copy of the third edition of *Defrauding America*. It was thought that you had more integrity than many others in Congress and would act upon the material. After 30 years of documenting congressional coverups and obstruction of justice, I am extremely skeptical, but felt that sending it will at least put you on notice of having been made aware of these charges, seeing the great amount of supporting evidence described in the book, and someday you too may be asked to describe what you did about it.

I am enclosing flyers that describe the area of government corruption that I and a group of other government agents discovered about high-level criminal and subversive behavior.

The book is heavily detailed and documented, and shows how the corruption has greatly expanded since I first discovered it and its influence on a series of very brutal airline disasters occurring in my area of federal air safety responsibilities.

The most easily understood corruption is the evidence showing 50 years of CIA drug trafficking into the United States, later aided by the DEA, the military, and organized crime.

You will never expose these criminal and subversive activities because of various factors, including the felony coverups and obstruction of justice by members of Congress for years. This coverup is a federal crime, and in this case, far worse of a felony than offenses for which many Americans have been sent to prison.

Also, the corruption is so widespread that unless the role of Justice Department personnel, federal judges, and others, is recognized, any investigation into the CIA's drug trafficking will be bushwhacked by those officials in key government positions.

If I were to send this letter as a request to investigate, it would indicate a naiveté that is prevented by the decades of evidence that I have accumulated of Congressional coverups and obstruction of justice. I mail letters such as this primarily to establish a record showing who knew of these criminal and subversive activities, when they were made aware of them, and their subsequent coverup.
