The Mafiosi provided this advance information to FBI agents in the New York City offices, who considered the information of exceptional importance.

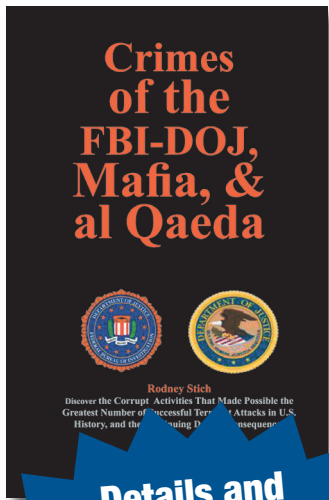

Cavalier Scheme Resulting in 4,000 Deaths To Protect a Key FBI Supervisor

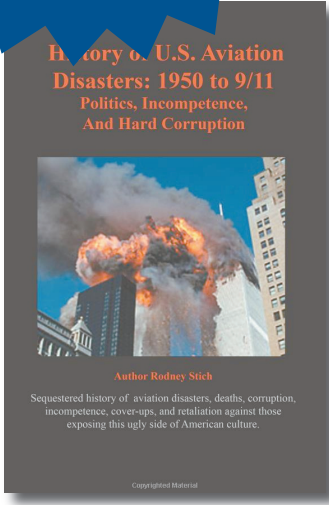

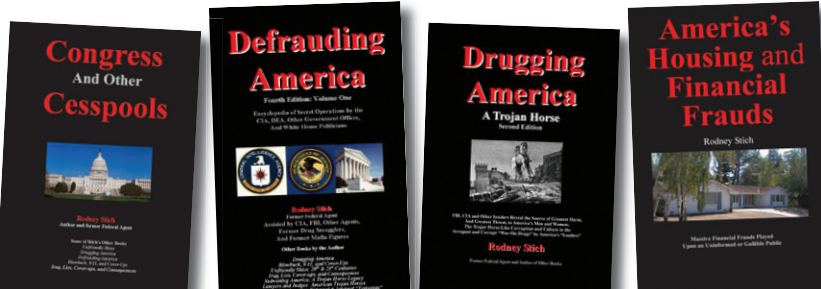
